Udawalawe National Park

Abhayagiri Dagoba

Dating back to the 1st century BC, this colossal dagoba was the ceremonial focus of the 5000-strong Abhayagiri Monastery. Originally over 100m high, it was one of the greatest structures in the ancient world,

Quadrangle

A short stroll north of the Royal Palace ruins, the area known as the Quadrangle is literally that – a compact group of ruins in a raised-up area bounded by a wall. It's the most concentrated collection of buildings...

World's End

The Horton Plains plateau comes to a sudden end at World's End, a stunning escarpment that plunges 880m. The walk here is 4km, but the trail then loops back to Baker's Falls (2km) and continues back to the entrance

Nuwara Eliya

A 19th century hill station Nuwara Eliya retains its colonial ambiance with its golf course, gentlemen's clubs and mock-Tudor buildings

Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage

Can you imagine anything as heartwarming as staring at baby elephants as they enjoy a river soak? And at this beautiful place in Sri Lanka

Mirissa

Spend your days, soaking in the sun on a hammock and whale-watching at the little village of Mirissa, one of the most appealing beach hideaways in Sri Lanka.

Yala National Park

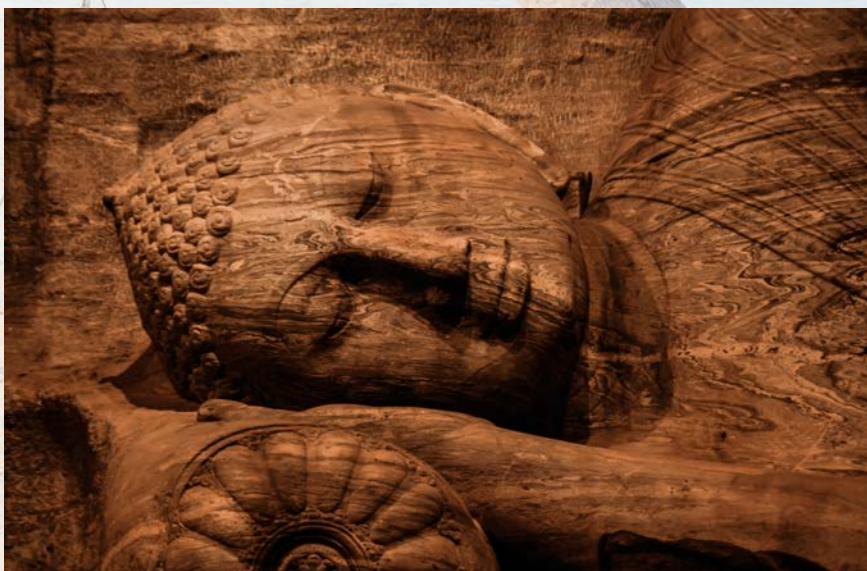


Temple Of The Tooth Relic

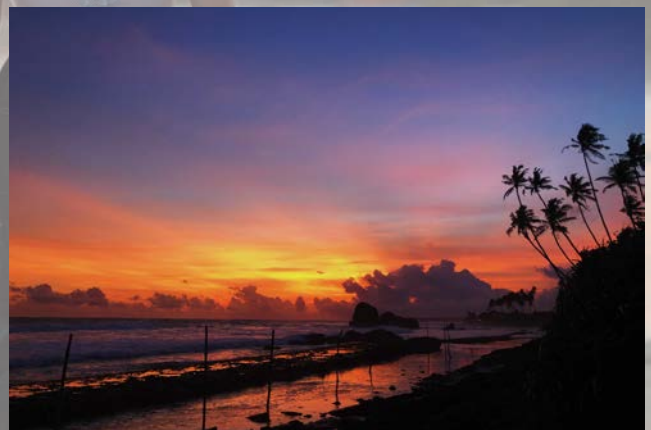
The new "old" beaches: Pasikuda and Kalkudah, world famous in the 70s.
